

Stage 1, Water Contingency Plan

Lake Worth is currently under water restrictions.

During Stage 1, landscape watering is limited to the following twice per week schedule. Watering with a soaker hose, drip irrigation or by hand is allowed at any time.

Exceptions:

- Foundations may be watered up to two hours on any day using a handheld hose, soaker hose or drip irrigation system placed within 24-inches of the foundation.
- Establishing new turf is discouraged. If hydro mulch, grass sod, or grass seed has been installed, watering is allowed for the first 30 days to establish roots. After that, the above schedule applies. This does not include over seeding.
- All users are encouraged to reduce the frequency of draining and refilling swimming pools.
- Washing of any motorized vehicle is limited to a hand-held bucket or a hand-held hose equipped with a positive-pressure shutoff nozzle for quick rinses. Vehicle washing may be done at any time on the premises of a commercial car wash or commercial service station.

Violations will receive an initial warning, with citations issued for subsequent violations. Conviction of a violation carries a fine of up to \$2,000 per day. Each day is considered a separate violation.



STAGE 1 WATERING SCHEDULE

MONDAY
No watering allowed

TUESDAY & FRIDAY
Non-residential sites (apartments, businesses, parks, common areas, etc.)

WEDNESDAY & SATURDAY
Residential addresses ending in 0,2,4,6,8

THURSDAY & SUNDAY
Residential addresses ending in 1,3,5,7,9
