1. Call to Order.

Mayor Walter Bowen called the Council Canvass/Special meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

2. Roll Call. (No quorum necessary for canvassing; only two members are required.)

Council members present were Mayor Walter Bowen, Myrt Fowlkes, Ronny Parsley, Pat O. Hill, Geoffrey White, and Clint Narmore. Curtis McKay and Perry Lunsford were absent.

Staff present was Brett McGuire, City Manager and Linda Rhodes, City Secretary.

3. Resolution #950- Canvass the returns of the November 8, 2011 Special Election and declaring the Results of said election for the determination of reauthorization of the Street Maintenance Sales Tax.

Linda Rhodes submitted Official Results of the election to the Mayor and Council Members present. The totals were the same as on the Unofficial Results, being: 77 voting in favor and 17 voting against the proposition to reauthorize the Street Maintenance Sales Tax of $\frac{1}{4}$ of one percent. The Street Maintenance Sales Tax reauthorization was approved.

Pat Hill made a motion, seconded by Myrt Fowlkes, to approve Resolution #950, canvassing the returns of the November 8, 2011 Special Election and declaring results of said election for the determination of reauthorization of the Street Maintenance Sales Tax. Motion passed with all members present voting in favor and none opposed.

4. Adjourn.


There being no further business, Mayor Walter Bowen closed the Council Canvass/Special meeting at 6:02 p.m.
