

Attention all Lake Worth Police Department Applicants

You must be a licensed peace officer in the State of Texas, or capable of obtaining Texas peace officer certification at the time of the conditional job offer, in order to apply for officer positions within the Lake Worth Police Department.

After obtaining the primary employment application, which you may download from the city web site, pick up from Lake Worth City Hall or have mailed to your residence:

- Be sure to provide complete addresses and phone numbers for all of your former employers and personal references. Include all street names, city names, states and postal codes.
