The following is a request form for neighborhood traffic calming. Each request must contain the completed information as indicated in sections A, B, and C. The request will be processed in accordance with the provisions of the Neighborhood Traffic Calming Program.

A. Street Study Information

Each request must provide the name of the street on which a study is requested and the boundaries of the street segment. Boundary limits may change at the discretion of the Planning & Public Works Departments. Traffic studies will be conducted only within the boundaries indicated. Please use street names for boundary limits, you may use block ranges if you think will be helpful.

C. Evidence of Neighborhood Support

Please provide evidence of neighborhood support for participation in the program. If a case cannot be handled administratively the applicant must provide signatures of a majority of the neighborhood (51%) **property owners** within the study area boundaries as evidence of support for participation in the program. Because non-administrative solutions involve potential changes to the neighborhood character, a majority of the neighborhood property owners must sign the petition for the case to move forward.
